Medicaid

Currently, there are approximately 40 categories of eligibility within New Mexico Medicaid providing no cost or low cost health insurance coverage to New Mexico's uninsured and financially eligible citizens.

Medicaid eligible recipients may obtain medical services from one of the Managed Care Organizations (MCOs):

- Molina
- Lovelace
- Presbyterian

New Mexikids is no cost or low cost health coverage for children under 19 years old with household incomes up to 235% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Copayments are based on income.
